Makin' Tracks 2025

The dates are set for food, games, fun, and memories at the Fisher/Anderson-Melby/Ostrem Family Reunion on August 1st-3rd, 2025, in Manfred and Harvey. Saturday, August 2nd, the celebration comes to Manfred. From the 1950s through the 1980s, there was a yearly family reunion at the Lars Ostrem yard. Since the passing of Lars in 1987, there have only been a handful of reunions of this family in Manfred.

Manfred has meant so much to all of us! Even though members of the families have long-since moved away, it is a part of our memories that we will cherish our entire lives. We are all blessed to have Manfred in our hearts. We are also blessed to have Manfred History and Preservation, Inc. taking wonderful care of the little town, giving us the chance to have the reunion exactly where it started.

Some brief family history:

- The Guy D. Fisher family moved from the Fergus Falls (MN) area to a farm southwest of Manfred in 1906.
- Olaf Anderson first settled in Mayville (ND) in 1895, moved west of Harvey in 1898, and then settled in Manfred in 1900.
- The Melbys settled near Northfield (MN) in 1881, near Cooperstown (ND) in 1887, and then northwest of Manfred in 1893.
- The Ostrems first settled south of Tioga (ND) in 1909. In 1929, Bendik Rogne asked Lars Ostrem to farm his land north of Manfred, so the family moved to the Manfred area that year.

Our theme for the reunion is "Makin' Tracks," as most of the family will travel long-distance to Manfred for the weekend celebration. The artwork for the "Makin' Tracks" theme has an interesting story. Larry and Carol Fisher, together with their children Sheryl and Jon, would frequently come to North Dakota to visit family and friends. One year, Larry built a luggage rack for the top of their vehicle and proceeded to paint this artwork onto the Fisher's luggage rack. On the engine you see "5 '39" which is Larry's birth month and year. The logo on the coal car and caboose is "S+JF," standing for Sheryl + Jon Fisher. When putting the reunion poster together this past summer, Mark sent Sheryl a picture copy of the luggage rack and Sheryl used the artwork to create the poster. Special thanks to Sheryl for thinking of the perfect theme for our reunion and to Larry for letting us use his artwork for the reunion poster!
